



## Toronto Rugby Union 2010 U18 Boys League Structure

**All coaches and team managers are expected to read the following league structure for the TRU U18 Boys.**

**Play Dates** (Wednesday for league fixtures only. **Please note that Brampton RFC plays home games on Thursday nights**)

August 4<sup>th</sup>

Playoffs: 1/4s – Aug 11<sup>th</sup>, Semi – Aug 18<sup>th</sup>, Final Aug 25<sup>th</sup>

### Points/Standings

Win = 4 points  
Draw = 1 point

#### *Bonus points*

4 tries scored in a game = 1 point  
Loss by 7 points or less = 1 point

### Playoffs

Cup Round - Top team in each division + 2 wild cards.

Plate Round – Next best 8 ranked using season standings

### Tie-breakers

#### **League games:**

All league games tied after 60 mins will remain a tie. Each team receives 1 point.

#### **Playoff games:**

Games tied after 60 mins will use two 10 minute overtime halves. Overtime is not sudden death. If still tied after extra time kicks will be used. Teams can use between 1 and 3 kickers and will kick at the same posts. Kicks are best result from all three of the following locations.

- a. 22m line in front of posts
- b. 22m line, 15 m in from left sideline
- c. 22 m line, 15 m in from right sideline

If still tied, repeat the process of kicks in a sudden death format.

### ***Standings:***

Ties in points (league standings) will be broken using the following in descending order.

1. Head- to- Head
2. Number of wins
3. Bonus Points
4. Point differential between tied teams
5. Total point differential
6. Total points against
7. Total points scored
8. Number of tries
9. Coin Toss

### **Substitutions**

***All teams may use unlimited-rolling substitutions. This is the rule for both league play and playoffs.***

### **Game-play**

All games will be played using 30 minute halves. All home teams must communicate a time change with the visiting team. Home teams are responsible for trainers and referees that are not assigned by the TDRRS.

### **Game Sheets and Scores**

Scores are to be called in to 416 907 8250 within 24 hours. Please include score, location, and number of tries for each team in the message. All game sheets must be faxed to 416 907 8251 within 72 hours of the game. Score reporting and faxing of the game sheet is the responsibility of the winning team.
